- 3. The applicant should be Pursuing a Graduate or Post Graduate Degree or Diploma.
- 4. The Total Annual Income of the Parent / Guardian should be less than or equal to ₹ 8.00 Lakh per Annum.
- 5. The applicant MUST NOT be the third sibling in his/her family who is availing of this scholarship.
- 6. Course Mode: Distance learning, part-time or weekend courses are not eligible.
- 7. Applicants **cannot receive any other scholarship or stipend** simultaneously. Accepting another scholarship leads to termination of benefits.
- 8. Awarded once per academic level; not renewable if the course is repeated.
- 9. The competent authority to issue Disability Certificate shall be a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or a State Government. The Central / State Government may constitute Medical Board(s) consisting of at least three members out of which at least one shall be a specialist in the particular field for assessing locomotor / cerebral/ visual / hearing disability, as the case may be.

- 1. The applicant must be pursuing a post-matric qualification, i.e. Class 11th, Class 12th, including Polytechnics, Post-Matriculation Diploma/Certificates and Bachelor's Degree/Diploma in India and Master's Degree/Diploma.
- 2. The applicant must be disabled, with disability percentage of 40% or above.
- 3. The Total Annual income of parents/guardians of the applicant (from all sources) must not exceed ₹ 2.50 Lakh per Annum.
- 4. The applicant must not be availing any other scholarship by the govt.
- 5. The applicant must not be the third sibling of the family who has been given this scholarship.
- 6. The competent authority to issue Disability Certificate shall be a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or a State Government. The Central / State Government may constitute Medical Board(s) consisting of at least three members out of which at least one shall be a specialist in the particular field for assessing locomotor / cerebral/ visual / hearing disability, as the case may be.
