1. NOTICE INVITING TENDER

Indian Institute of Information Technology Dharwad (IIIT Dharwad) invites bids through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) Portal from eligible and competent bidders for supply of photography, videography and video editing equipment as detailed in this tender document and the corresponding GeM Bid.

6.1 New and Genuine Products

All products supplied shall be brand new, unused and genuine. Refurbished, used, repaired, demo or counterfeit products shall not be accepted.

6.2 Make and Model

The bidder shall clearly mention the exact make and model offered. The accepted make/model shall not be changed without prior written approval of the Institute.

6.3 Technical Compliance

The bidder shall submit a point-by-point compliance statement against the prescribed technical specifications. Deviations, if any, shall be clearly indicated.

6.4 Experience

The bidder should have a minimum of 3 years of experience in the supply of photography, videography, camera, audio-visual or related equipment to Government Departments, Government Institutions, PSUs, Educational Institutions, Autonomous Bodies or reputed organisations. Documentary evidence such as Purchase Orders/Work Orders/Contracts and corresponding completion/supply certificates or invoices shall be submitted.

6.5 Company / Firm Registration

The bidder shall be a legally registered entity/firm/company and shall submit valid documentary proof of registration, as applicable. Valid PAN and GST Registration Certificate shall also be submitted, wherever applicable.

6.6 OEM Authorization

The bidder shall be an OEM or an authorised dealer/distributor/reseller of the quoted products, wherever applicable. For all branded products proposed in the bid, the bidder shall submit a valid OEM Authorization Certificate / Authorised Dealership Certificate issued by the respective OEM. The OEM Authorization shall be submitted for each OEM/brand proposed and shall clearly indicate authority to quote, supply and provide warranty/after-sales service support. The authorization shall be duly signed by the authorised signatory of the respective OEM. Where issued electronically/digitally, it shall be verifiable through the OEM's official communication/verification mechanism.

6.7 Financial Capacity

The bidder shall have adequate financial capacity to execute the order successfully. The bidder shall submit audited financial statements for the last three financial years, wherever applicable; and/or a turnover certificate issued by a Chartered Accountant indicating annual turnover for the last three financial years; and Income Tax Return acknowledgement/relevant financial documents, wherever applicable. The bidder shall meet the minimum financial/turnover requirement specified in the GeM Bid, if any.

6.8 Warranty

A minimum 36-month warranty shall be provided for equipment wherever such warranty is available from the OEM. The actual OEM warranty for each item shall be clearly stated.

6.9 Service Support

The bidder shall coordinate with the OEM/authorised service centre for warranty and service support. Camera/gimbal servicing shall preferably be through authorised service arrangements of the respective OEM, as applicable.

6.10 Delivery

The bidder shall safely transport and deliver the equipment to IIIT Dharwad within the delivery period specified in the GeM Bid/Contract.

6.11 Damage in Transit

Any damage occurring during transportation shall be rectified or the affected item replaced by the bidder at no additional cost to the Institute.

6.12 Inspection and Acceptance

All supplies shall be inspected by the Institute/authorised committee. Acceptance shall be subject to conformity with the approved specifications, physical condition, accessories, serial numbers and warranty.

6.13 Demonstration

The successful bidder shall provide basic demonstration of the equipment and its operation after delivery, wherever applicable.

6.14 Accessories

All standard accessories required for normal operation and included in the OEM package shall be supplied along with the equipment.

6.15 Serial Numbers

The bidder shall provide item-wise serial numbers, model/part numbers, warranty details and date of supply along with delivery documents.

6.16 Software Licence

Software shall be supplied with a valid and legitimate licence for the specified period. Trial, cracked, pirated or unauthorised software shall not be accepted.

6.17 Replacement of Defective Items

Items found defective, damaged or not conforming to the approved specifications shall be replaced by the bidder at no additional cost to the Institute.

6.18 Price

The quoted price shall include all applicable costs such as packing, forwarding, transportation, insurance, delivery, installation/setup, testing, demonstration and other incidental charges, wherever applicable. GST shall be as per applicable law and the GeM Bid format.

6.19 Payment

Payment shall be released after satisfactory delivery, inspection and acceptance and submission of required documents, subject to the GeM contract and applicable Institute rules.

6.20 No Substitution

Substitution of the approved product with another make/model shall not be permitted without prior written approval of the Institute.

6.21 Queries / Clarifications

Bidders shall submit all queries/clarifications relating to the Bid Document within the period prescribed in the GeM Bid. The Institute may issue clarification/corrigendum based on the queries received. Bidders shall be responsible for taking into account all such clarifications/corrigenda while submitting their bids.

6.22 Clarifications Issued by IIIT Dharwad

Clarifications issued by IIIT Dharwad during/after the Pre-Bid Meeting, if any, shall be uploaded/communicated through the GeM portal, wherever applicable, and shall form part of the bidding document.

6.23 Verbal Clarifications

No individual clarification, commitment or assurance given verbally during the Pre-Bid Meeting or any other interaction shall be binding on the Institute unless the same is formally issued through the GeM portal/corrigendum.

6.24 Variation in Quantity

The Institute shall reserve the right, subject to applicable GeM provisions and contract conditions, to increase or decrease the ordered quantity up to 25%, wherever permissible, by giving reasonable notice and commensurate delivery period.

6.25 EMD / Bid Security

The EMD/Bid Security, if applicable, shall be as specified in the GeM Bid Document and shall be submitted in the manner prescribed therein.

6.26 EMD Exemption

Bidders seeking exemption from EMD/Bid Security shall submit the relevant and valid exemption documents as prescribed under the applicable GeM provisions and Government procurement rules.

6.27 Performance Security

The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security/Performance Bank Guarantee, wherever applicable, as specified in the GeM Bid and tender conditions.

6.28 Validity of Performance Security

The Performance Security shall remain valid for the period prescribed in the tender/GeM conditions and shall cover the contractual obligations of the successful bidder.

6.29 Forfeiture of Bid Security

The bidder shall submit a self-declaration to this effect along with the bid.

6.31 Compliance with Statutory Requirements

The successful bidder shall comply with all applicable statutory, regulatory, taxation and other requirements relevant to the supply and execution of the contract.

6.32 Compliance with GeM

All applicable GeM General Terms and Conditions, Bid-specific conditions and statutory requirements shall be binding on the successful bidder.

6.33 Right of Acceptance / Rejection

IIIT Dharwad reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, in whole or in part, subject to applicable procurement rules and GeM terms and conditions.

6.34 Conflict with GeM Conditions

In case of any conflict between the provisions of this tender document and the applicable GeM General Terms and Conditions, Bid-specific conditions or contractual provisions, the applicable GeM provisions shall prevail.

7. DELIVERY, INSPECTION AND HANDOVER

Delivery shall be made at IIIT Dharwad, Dharwad, Karnataka, within the period specified in the GeM Bid/Contract.

The bidder shall submit invoice, delivery challan, warranty documents, serial-number list and software licence details, wherever applicable.

The Institute may verify the supplied equipment against the approved technical specifications and product documentation. Final acceptance shall be issued only after satisfactory inspection and demonstration, wherever applicable.

 - Clarifications/documents sought by the Institute, where permissible under the applicable procurement procedure.
- Only technically acceptable bids shall be considered further in accordance with the GeM Bid conditions and applicable procurement procedure.

9. WARRANTY AND AFTER-SALES SERVICE

Warranty shall cover manufacturing defects and failures arising under normal use, subject to the OEM warranty terms. The bidder shall facilitate warranty service and replacement/repair of defective components through the OEM/authorised service network. Any service exclusions shall be clearly disclosed in the bid.

10. REPAIR & MAINTENANCE SERVICE

Where repair and maintenance service is quoted, the bidder shall provide the service scope, applicable period, response mechanism and authorised service details. Periodic servicing may include sensor cleaning, calibration and firmware

checks; unplanned repairs may include camera, lens, gimbal and connector-related servicing, as applicable to the approved scope.
